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Rule #4 Average Requirements: Entrants shall use their highest USBC average in the following order:

- A. As of the end of the previous winter season, for 21 games or more, OR:
- B. As of the end of the previous summer season, for 21 games or more, OR:
- C. Current average as of January 1 of current season with a minimum of 21 games or more, OR:
- D. Current average of at least 12 games in a USBC certified league, as of the first date of tournament participation.
- E. If Sport bowling average is the only average available, entrant will abide by the average adjustment scale of current USBC Rule book.
- F. If none of the above applies, entrant will be permitted to bowl using scratch figure of 240.
- G. The delivery hand used in this tournament must be the same as that used when the average was established.
- H. Entrant may request tournament AVERAGE RELIEF in compliance with USBC Rule 4e. If average relief is granted, this rule will supersede the average rules of this tournament.
- I. USBC Rules 319a-2, 319c, 319d, and 319e do not apply (average adjustments).
