

2021 MIDWEST WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT

COVID-19 GUIDELINES/RESTRICTIONS

As of now in order to comply with the Indiana Governor's mandates and Indiana state and local health departments' COVID-19 Restrictions, the following guidelines will be observed, unless notified otherwise.

- Masks must be worn in the bowling centers at all times except when you are physically bowling on the approach or actively drinking or eating.
- No spectators or guests will be allowed. (Should conditions dramatically improve in the next few months, this restriction may be lifted.)
- A 1-lane courtesy and time limits (rule 9) will be strictly enforced to ensure bowlers are off the lanes within the allotted time. Time limits will be 3 hours for the team event and 4 hours for the D/S event.
- To follow allowed capacity requirements, we request that bowlers arrive no earlier than one hour prior to their scheduled squad time.
- Bowlers will record their scores on the recap sheets. When all the games are completed, the lane monitors will collect the scores and upon request provide a copy to the team captain or doubles pair. The lane monitor will turn the scores in to the Tournament Office.
- We will support the seating plan identified by the center that allows maximum distancing within the spaces available.

To limit contact:

- If at all possible, we ask that substitution forms and any necessary average verifications be sent to the tournament manager at least 5 days prior to tournament competition.
- Only Team Captains will be allowed in the tournament office.
- All bowlers must be USBC certified prior to competition. Anyone not currently bowling in a certified league and who has not yet purchased their 2020-21 USBC membership may do so online at <http://www.bowl.com/join/>.
